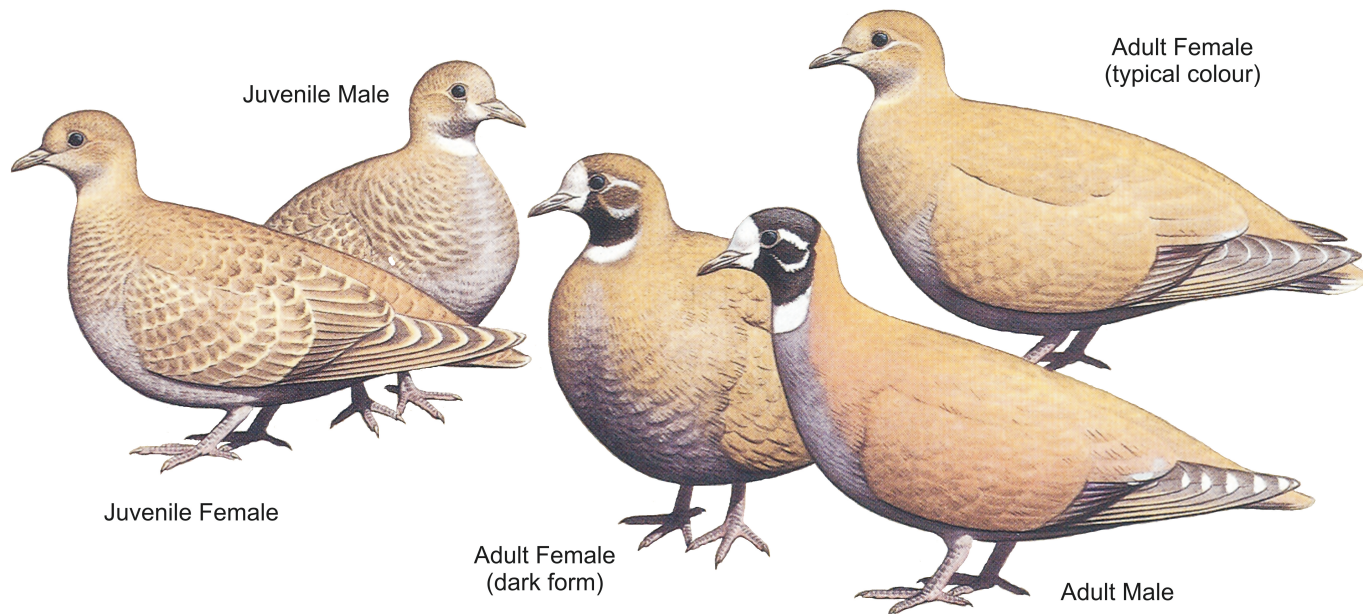


Flock Bronzewing *Phaps histrionica*

Morphometrics:

	Adult Male	Adult Female
Wing:	189 – 221 mm	189 – 212 mm
Tail:	70 – 94 mm	75 – 86 mm
Weight:	235 – 355 g	260 – 320 g

Ageing & Sexing:

	Adult (1+)	Juvenile
Bill:	black to dark blue-grey;	horn, but darkens to adult colour by 70 days;
Legs & feet:	dull red;	pinkish, but red like adults by 100 days;
Front of face:	male – white; female – typically light brown, but dark form is dull white;	male - off-white to pale brown; female – brown;
Crown:	male – black; female – light brown;	male – light brown; female – mid-brown (darker than male)
Ear coverts:	male – black; female – typically light brown, but dark brown in dark form;	male – light brown; female – same as crown;
General plumage variation is well depicted in the illustrations above; Juveniles moult to adult plumage between 40 and 180 days. So adults are aged (1+).		

Incubation is shared by both sexes.
