

Bill: straw-yellow or yellowish-green; straw-yellow with purple-grey base;

Iris: dark brown; blackish brown;

Legs & feet: blue-grey; light blue-grey with purple tinge;

Head, neck & white to creamy-white usually pale to light grey tinged with buff tips to

upperparts: tinged grey; feathers when fresh;

Vent: mostly white but some feathers washed buff & no black spots;

have large black subterminal spots;

Thighs: similar to vent; dark grey suffusion and buff tips to some

feathers:

Undertail white with black subterminal bands mostly buff to orange-buff and no barring;

Coverts: giving a barred appearance;

Post-juvenile moult to adult plumage commences at about 140 days old and is completed before the end of the first year. Thus adults are aged (1+).

Sexing:

There is no apparent sexual dimorphism in size or plumage. Both sexes incubate
