

Ageing:

Juveniles lack the purple-rose cap of adults.

Juveniles moult to adult plumage within 120 days of fledging. Thus adults are aged (1+).

Sexing:

Sexes differ only slightly in adult plumage as follows:

Hindneck: greyish blue-green contrasting with green – contrasting little from green of

green back; rest of upperparts;

Chin & throat: light yellow to cream; pale yellow;

Upper breast: light blue with green bases to feathers; bluish-green with small dull blue tips to

feathers;

Lower breast: green with pale blue fringes and centre similar to male, but mauve patch is

Both sexes incubate.
