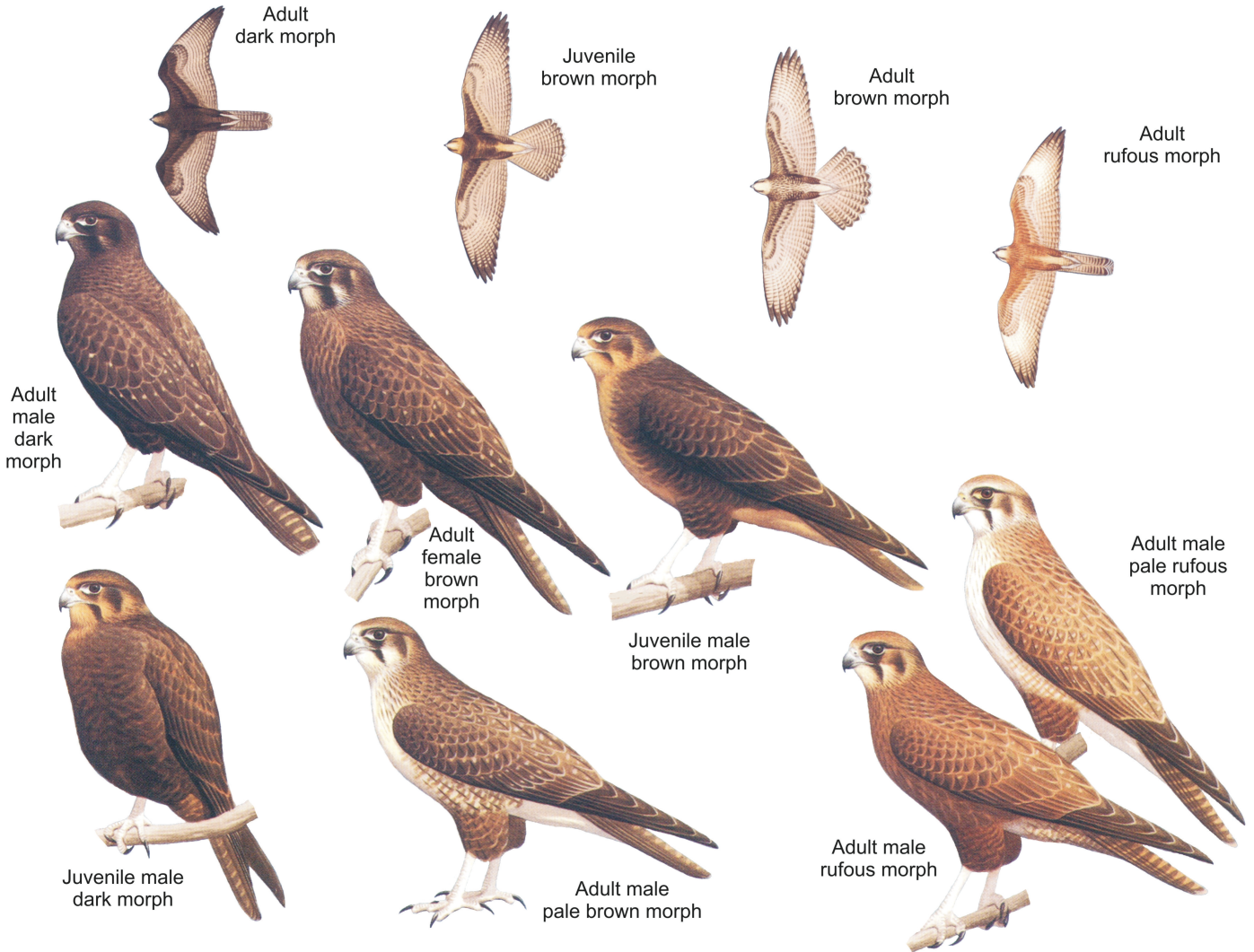


Brown Falcon *Falco berigora*

Morphometrics:

There are no significant difference in size between morphs or age classes:

	Adult Male	Adult Female
Wing:	299 – 351 mm	329 – 390 mm
Tail:	169 – 220 mm	248 – 288 mm
Weight:	316 – 590 g	430 – 860 g

Ageing:

	Adult (2+)	Juvenile
Bill:	mostly pale grey, pale blue-grey, or whitish with black tip;	whitish-grey with black tip;
Cere & orbital ring:	usually pale grey to pale bluish-grey, but in a few yellow, yellowish grey or greenish yellow	pale grey or bluish grey;
Iris:	dark brown or brown to dark red-brown, but with age may fade to light brown or hazel, esp. in males;	dark brown;
Legs & feet:	pale blue-grey to pale grey or white with yellowish tinge;	same as adults but never with yellowish tinge.

Sexing:

Females larger than males;
Incubation shared, but mostly by female – so both sexes will develop a brood patch.
