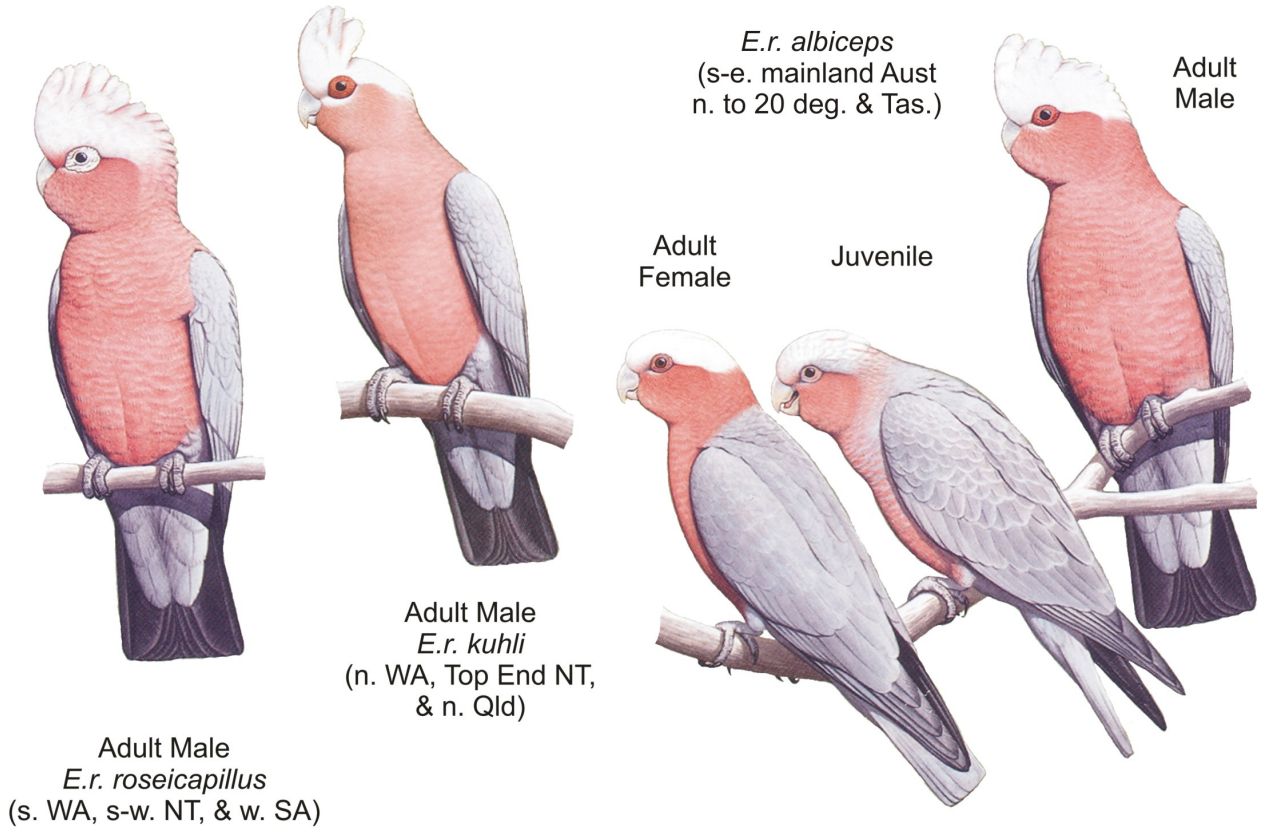


Galah *Eolophus roseicapillus*

Ageing & Sexing:

	Adult Male (2+)	Adult Female (2+)	Juvenile/Immature (J), (1)
Bill:	bone-white often grading to pale grey at base;	same as adult male;	as for adults, but juveniles have yellow tinge;
Iris:	black-brown;	pink or orange-pink;	initially black-brown, but female starts to become paler at about 6 months;
Bare skin around eye:	broad pink to dark pink or pinkish-red;	narrower and paler than adult male;	initially pale yellow-grey, turns pink from 6 months;
Crown & nape:	white;	white;	grey white or pale pink;
Underparts:	dark pink;	dark pink;	dirty-grey suffusion on breast;

Adult plumage is attained in a complete moult early in the second year;
Both sexes incubate.
