Orbital skin:	orange-yellow to yellow;	pale bluish-white;
Iris:	black-brown;	black-brown to black;
Legs & feet:	orange-yellow to yellow;	dull yellow;
Nape & hindneck:	grey;	grey speckled black;
Underparts:	white;	white speckled black;

It is thought that adult plumage and bare part colouring are achieved by early in the second year, so age Immatures (2-) and Adults (2+).

**Sexing:**

Females are considerably larger than males (see measurements above);  
Both sexes incubate.
