


## Latham's Snipe



### Ageing:

Latham's Snipe breed in Japan, nearby Asian mainland and islands; On arrival in Australia in September juveniles retain some fledgling plumage and all remiges and rectrices which are replaced in a complete moult by the first Austral summer Thus adults are (2+); Juveniles are most readily identified from adults by the pattern on median secondary coverts as illustrated below:



### Sexing:

Sexes similar in size and plumage.

### Similar Species:

Three *Gallinago* snipe species are known to migrate to Australia in the non-breeding season. The three species are very similar in plumage, except for tail structure:
