

Ageing:

Swinhoe's Snipe breed in Siberia and Mongolia and then migrate to s-e Asia, Pacific islands and a some reach northern Australia from the Kimberley to Cape York in mid-October. Immatures are very similar to adults and can be aged as juvenile/immature (1) only on the basis of remnant juvenile plumage;

Adults will be aged (2+),

Sexing:

Sexes similar in size and plumage.

Similar Species:

Three *Gallinago* snipe species are known to migrate to Australia in the non-breeding season. The three species are very similar in plumage, except for tail structure:
