


White-browed Crake *Porzana cinerea* **Species No.: 52** **Band size: 06**

Ageing:

	Adult (1+)	Juvenile
Bill:	lower mandible, tip & tomia of upper mandible olive-yellow or orange-brown brown, rest of upper mandible dark olive-brown with light red band at base;	as adult, but band at base of upper mandible is orange;
Iris:	red, reddish-brown or dark brown;	red;
Legs & feet:	light green or greenish olive with yellow -olive tinge to front of tarsus & tibia;	blue-green to light blue-grey, but lacking yellow tinge of adults;
Forehead & crown:	grey with blackish scalloping;	brown;
Underparts:	flanks olive-grey grading to pale grey at edges of whit breast & belly;	flanks buffish brown, feathers have white centres & concealed dark grey bases.

No information on timing or extent of moult. Thus adults should be recorded only as aged (1+).

Sexing:

Sexes similar in size and plumage;
No information on incubation roles.
