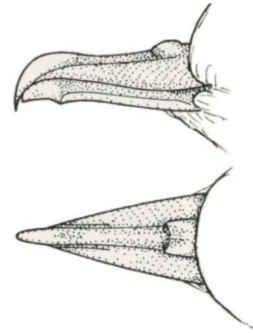
Adult, dorsal



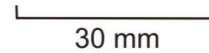

**Identification:**

Narrow terminal black band on tail which spans t1 to t4, but t5 & t6 are entirely grey;  
Length and width of bill (see illustrations above).

**Morphometrics:**

Tarsus:	29.5 – 35.5 mm	29 – 34.8 mm
Toe:	35 – 40 mm	35 – 42 mm
Weight:	115 – 186 g	

**Ageing:**

Juveniles (1) have high culmen, greater bill depth and soft latericorn;  
Juveniles leave nest burrows / rock crevices mid- March to early April  
Adults return to nest sites from late September to early November;  
Age of first breeding unknown, so age breeding birds (2+).

**Sexing:**

No sexual dimorphism in size or plumage;  
Adults sexed on cloaca and distended abdomen iduring breeding season;  
Both sexes incubate.
