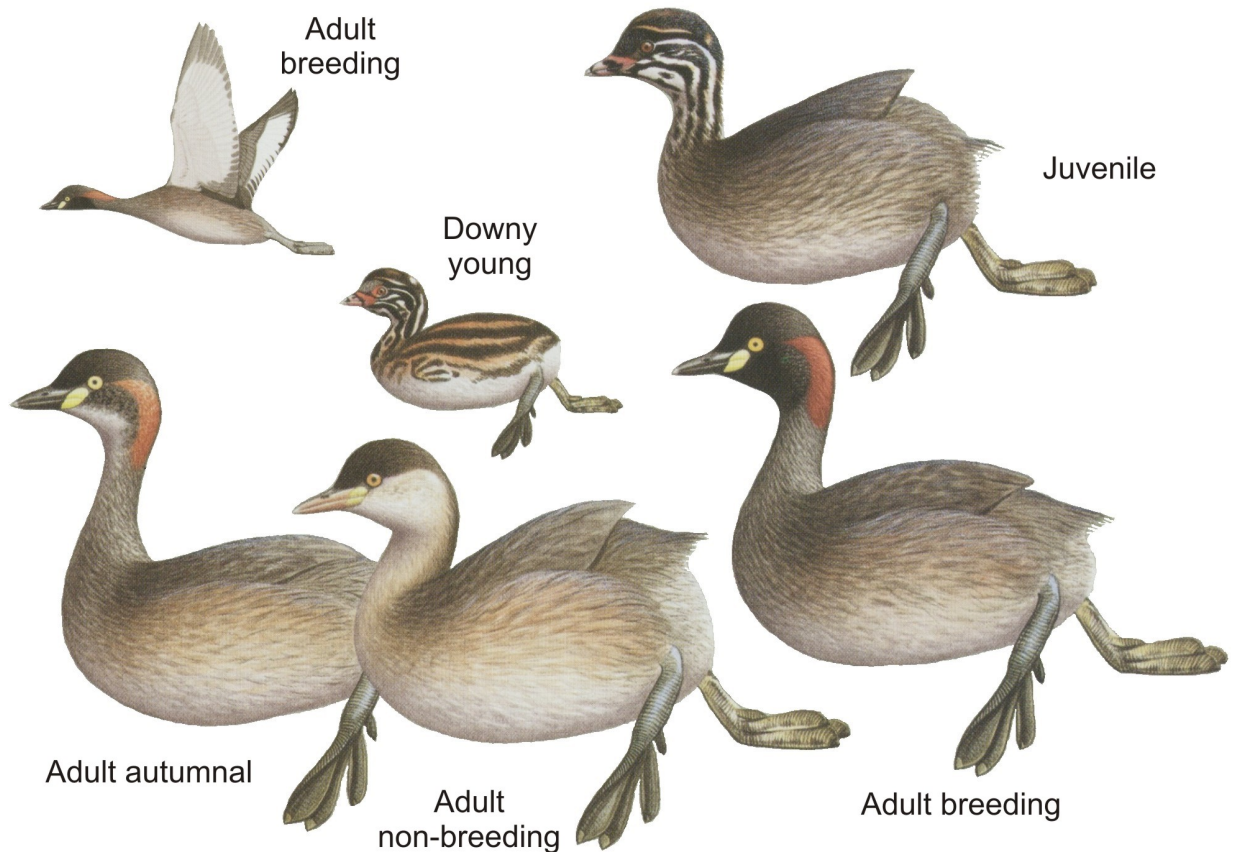


Australasian Grebe *Tachybaptus novaehollandiae* Species No.: 61 Band size: 09 (10) SS

Ageing:

No information as to how long the striped head and neck of Juveniles (J) or (1) is retained, but certainly lost in moult to adult-like non-breeding plumage within first year; Juveniles and possibly adult-like immatures can be separated from adults by the double row of scales on hind edge of tarsus are fused and serrations are slight or absent; The hind edge of the tarsus of adults has two parallel rows of serrated scales; Age adults as (2+)

Sexing:

Adult males are larger than adult females – see morphometrics above; Both sexes incubate.
