

Ageing:

Adult (2+) Juvenile (1)

Bill: black with sharply defined cream to similar to adult but yellow of upper

buff-yellow, or straw-yellow at base mandible is smaller than adult and and on the upper mandible this tapers does not extend to nostril;

to a point a nostril:

Iris: pale yellow to straw-yellow; straw yellow;

Supercilium: narrow white; broad white, broken by black-brown

marking behind eye;

Upper wing: see illustrations

Adult plumage is assumed to be attained with a complete pre-basic moult early in the second year, so adults should be aged (2+).

## Sexing:

Sexes similar.

Role of sexes in incubation is unknown.
