
## Double-banded Plover Charadrius bicinctus Species No.: 140 Band size: 04 IN



## Morphometrics:

Two subspecies - *C.b bicinctus* breeds throughout NZ including Ruapuke and Stewart Islands and migrates to coastal eastern and southern Australia in the non-breeding season; *C.b exilis* breeds only on Auckland Island where it is uncommon and sedentary. The measurements below are for *C.b. bicinctus* which occur in Australia from March to August:

## Ageing:

Age of birds at time of pre-adult plumage moults has not been recorded See illustrations for plumage differences. However immatures retain some white-fringed innermost wing coverts; Juvenile and non-breeding immatures (which retain remnant juvenile plumage) - birds should be aged (J) or (1) and all others (2+).

## Sexing:

Breeding plumage birds can be sexed on plumage – see illustrations; Incubation by both sexes.
