
Marsh Sandpiper Tringa stagnatilis Species No.: 159 Band size: 05 IN

Ageing:

On arrival in non-breeding areas juveniles (J) have fresh primaries, whereas adults (2+) have suspended moult with contrast between fresh inner and worn outer primaries;

Immatures (1) are distinguished by worn, retained juvenile primaries - outer primaries are replaced by Feb. – Mar. and most attain full adult non-breeding plumage by late April and migrate to breeding area with adults;

Some immatures do not commence primary moult until May – June and therefore remain in non-breeding areas.

Sexing:

Sexes are not dimorphic in either plumage or size.
