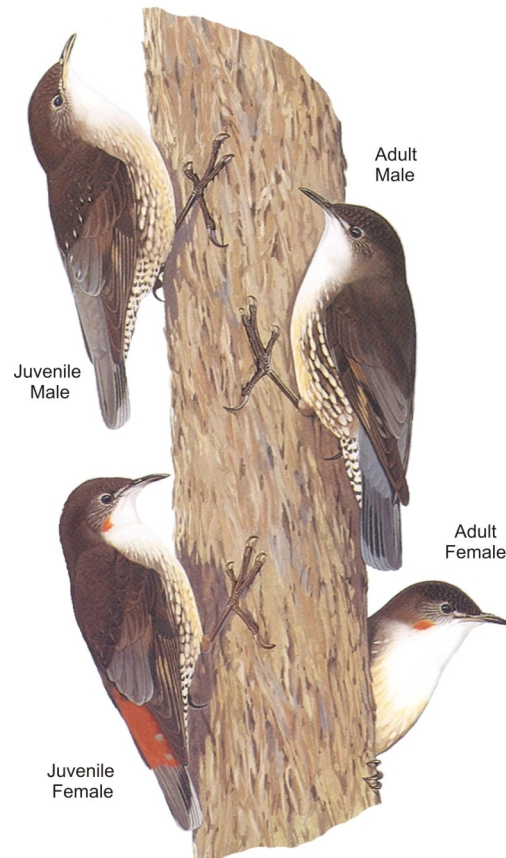


White-throated Treecreeper *Cormobates leucophaea* Species No.: 558 Band size: 03 AY



Morphometrics:

Ageing:

- Post juvenile moult (post-breeding moult time for adults) results in almost identical plumage to adults in both sexes;
- Immature (1) has dull black bill with white base and underside to lower mandible, yellow/cream palate and gape;
- Adults (1+) have a black bill with a pale base to the lower mandible and black gape.

Sexing :

- Juvenile males have plumage that is almost identical to adult males, but can have dark streaks or smudges on upperparts;
- Juvenile females have a chestnut rump and the typical female chestnut spot on the side of the throat.
- Males do not have a chestnut spot below the ear coverts on the side of the neck.
