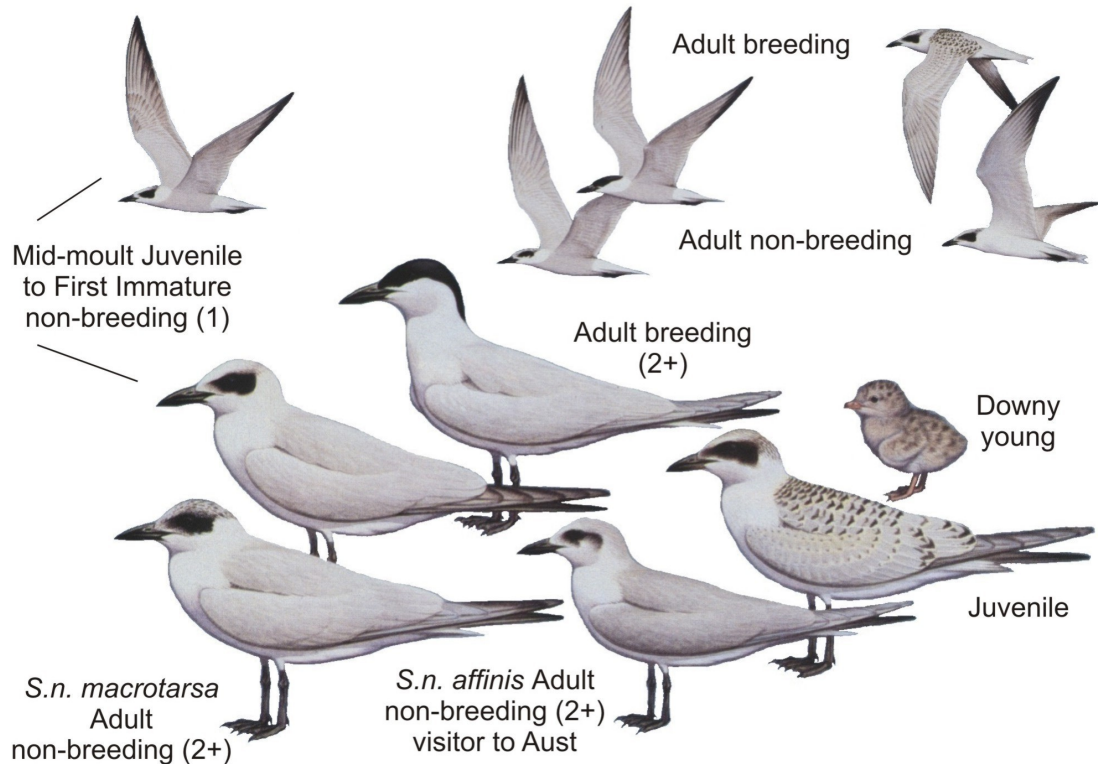


**Australian Gull-billed Tern *Gelochelidon macrotarsa* Species No.: 8795 Band size: 07 AM**  
 (formerly Gull-billed Tern *Sterna nilotica* – species code 111)



**Status:**

The Australian Gull-billed Tern was formerly considered a subspecies of *Sterna nilotica*. As a consequence of taxonomic review in 2019, the Australian subspecies was redefined as one of two species in the genus *Gelochelidon*.

No sexual dimorphism in plumage, but females tend to be marginally smaller than males in all measurements;
