
Australian Gull-billed Tern Gelochelidon macrotarsa Species No.: 111 Band size: 07 AM

Status:

The Australian Gull-billed Tern was formerly considered a subspecies of Sterna nilotica. As a consequence of taxonomic review in 2019, the Australian subspecies was redefined as one of two species in the genus Gelochelidon.
