

Ageing:

Adult Juvenile Bill: black, but dark grey between rugose black-brown and smooth;

plates:

Head & neck: bare black skin and on hindneck & nape

fissured exposing pink underneath forming wart-like appearance;

Underwing: strip of bare skin – red; black-brown skin lightly covered by

feathers with black-brown shaft-

streaks or tips; dark dull pink;

Sexing:

No sexual dimorphism in plumage or bare parts, but adult males overall marginally larger than adult female and males have a definitively longer bill than females (see measurements above); Both sexes incubate.
