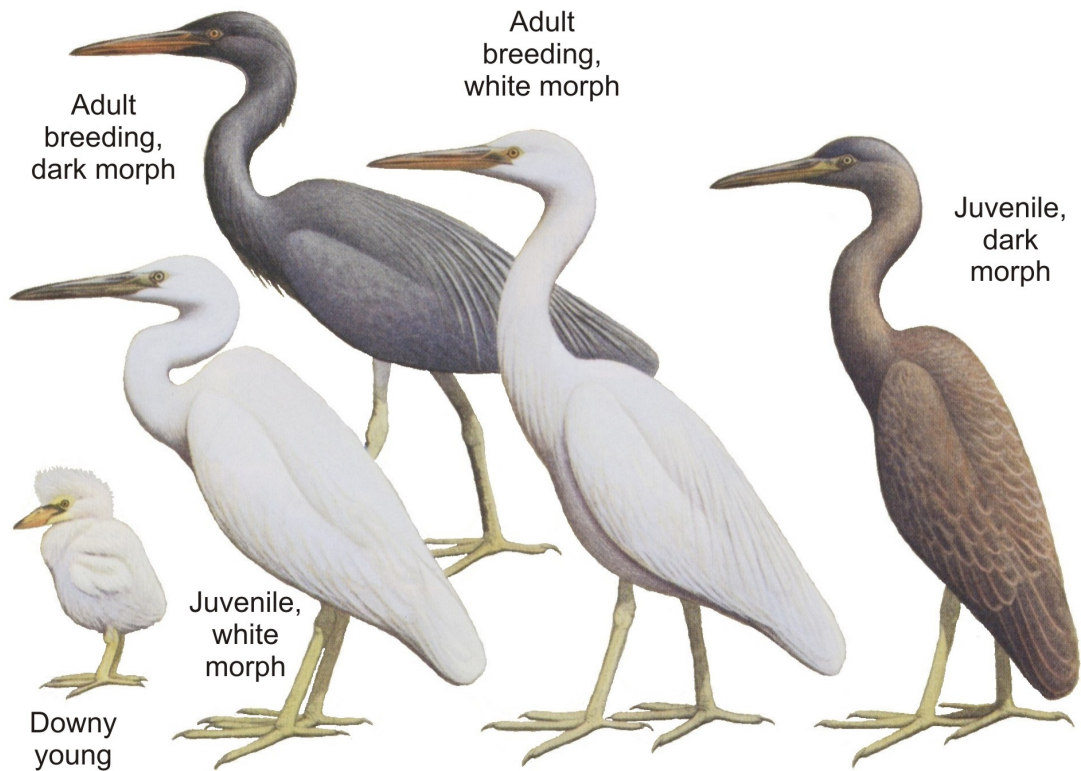


**Eastern Reef Egret** *Egretta sacra* Species No.: 191 Band size: 10 SS AM

**Ageing:**

	Adults	Juvenile / Immature
Iris:	orange to orange yellow;	straw yellow;
Bill:	orange-buff, upper mandible middle is black-brown, lower mandible tip black-brown;	similar to adult, but browner;
Legs & feet:	pale green with scutes on front of tarsus and toes grey-black.	buff with scutes on front of tarsus and toes dark olive-green.

Timing and duration of moults in Australia is unknown; Juvenile plumage is retained for about one year, so age breeding plumaged birds (2+).

**Sexing:**

No sexual difference recorded in size or plumage. Incubation by both sexes.
