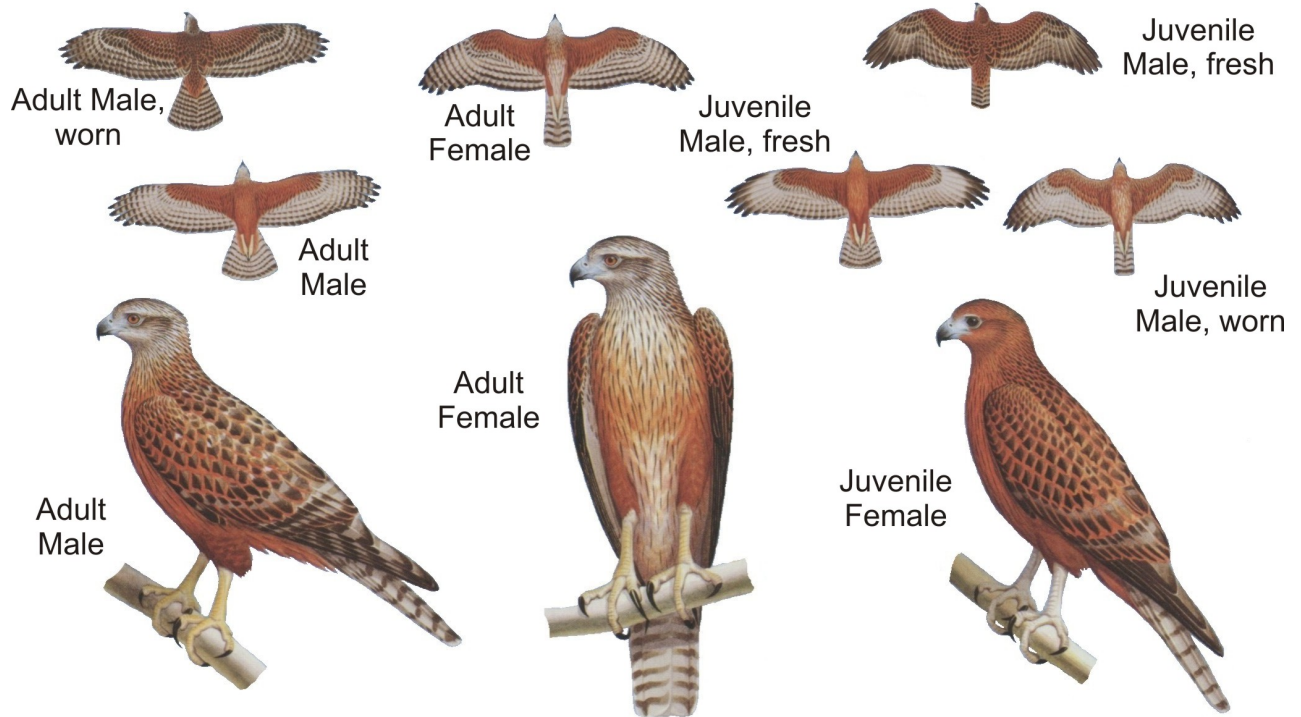


Red Goshawk *Erythrotriorchis radiatus* Species No.: 223 Band size: 11M 12F SS

Ageing:

Juvenile lacks pale head and underparts of adults (see illustrations);
 There is no data on moult and plumage development that could be useful for accurate ageing;
 There is some argument as to whether an immature plumage actually exists or whether extent of paleness of plumage is only age related, therefore age adult plumaged birds as (1+) unless they are breeding, in which case they should be aged as (2+);

Sexing:

Females are considerably larger than males;
 Incubation by female only.
