

## Ageing:

Finish partial post-juvenile moult to immature non-breeding plumage soon after arrival in non-breeding areas – age (1);

Undergo first pre-breeding moult to first immature breeding plumage in April-June, appearing similar to adult breeding plumage, but most retain all juvenile remiges and all retain some juvenile tertials and wing coverts which have worn pale-buff fringes – still age (1);

Some immatures remain in Australia for their first winter;

Adult non-breeding plumage in first attained early in their second Austral spring – age (2); Moult twice annually with complete post-breeding moult to non-breeding plumage during and just after southern migration and pre-breeding partial moult to adult breeding plumage just before northern migration – age (2+):

## Sexing:

No sexual differences in size;

Immature males can resemble adult breeding females;

Immature females are often much duller than breeding females;

Breeding females are slightly duller than breeding males, however, both sexes vary greatly, so it is only possible to sex known breeding pairs.
