RECOVERY ROUND-UP

This section is prepared with the co-operation of the Secretary, Australian Bird and Bat Banding Schemes, Australian Nature Conservation Agency. The recoveries are only a selection of the thousands received each year; they are not a complete list and should not be analysed in full or part without prior consent of the banders concerned. Longevity and distance records refer to the ABBBS unless otherwise stated. The distance is the shortest distance in kilometres along the direct line joining the place of banding and recovery; the compass direction refers to the same direct line. (There is no implication regarding the distance flown or the route followed by the bird). Where available ABBBS age codes have been included in the banding data.

Recovery or longevity items may be submitted directly to me whereupon their merits for inclusion will be considered.

Black-browed Albatross Thalassarche melanophris

131-85964. Adult (1+) banded by SOSS at sea east of Wollongong, NSW (34°25'S, 151°00'E) on 10 Aug. 1996. Recovered dead (tangled in fishing gear) at sea 70 miles south-west of Punta Lavapie, Chile (38°00'S, 74°30'W) in Jan. 1999. 10 692 km SSE.

(This is the longest movement recorded for the species.)

Australasian Gannet Morus serrator

131-95053. Nestling banded by C. G. Cooper at Lawrence Rocks State Faunal Reserve, Portland, Vic. (38°25'S, 141°40'E) on 31 Jan. 1997. Recovered dead on the south-east coast of Mauritius Island (20°17'S 57°33'E) on 27 Feb. 1997, 27 days after banding. 8 126 km WSW.

(This is the longest movement recorded for the species.)

Intermediate Egret Ardea intermedia

101-16318. Nestling banded by R. Jones at Bora Channel, Macquarie Marshes Nature Reserve, NSW on 16 Dec. 1998. Colour marking sighted in field (band number inferred) at Toonpan Lagoon, Townsville, Qld. on 18 Apr. 1999. 1 246 km N.

Straw-necked Ibis Threskiomis spinicollis

121-00627. Nestling banded by M. H. Waterman at Mullin's Swamp near Millicent, SA on 16 Nov. 1974. Recovered dead south-east of Deniliquin, NSW on 1 June 1998, over 23 years 6 months after banding. 487 km ENE.

Bar-tailed Godwit Limosa lapponica

071-85863. Adult (1+) banded by AWSG at Beaches Crab Creek Road, Roebuck Bay, Broome, WA (18°00'S, 122°22'E) on 27 Mar. 1990. Recovered (shot) on Mactan Island, Cebu, Philippines (10°18'N, 123°58'E) on 1 May 1999, over 9 years 1 month after banding. 3 151 km N.

Ruddy Turnstone Arenaria interpres

051-16179. Immature (1) banded by VWSG on Swan Island, Queenscliff, Vic. on 30 June 1984. Recaptured (released alive with band) on Mud Island, Port Phillip Bay, Vic. on 20 Mar. 1999, over 14 years 8 months after banding. 8 km ESE.

Curlew Sandpiper Calidris ferruginea

041-98578. Adult (2+) banded by VWSG at Werribee Sewerage Farm, Vic. (38°05'S, 144°31'E) on 27 Dec. 1998. Recovered dead at Ben Tre-App 150 km south-west of Siagon, Vietnam (11°55'N, 105°55'E) on 17 Apr. 1999. 6 856 km NW.

Pacific Gull Larus pacificus

110-97082. Adult (4+) banded by SSG-BOAT on Curlew Island, Tas. on 24 Nov. 1984. Recovered dead on South Bruny Island. Tas. on 18 Apr. 1999, over 14 years 4 months after banding. 1 km E.

Kelp Gull Larus dominicanus

(a) 110-92730. Nestling banded by SSG-BOAT on Green Island, Tas. on 14 Dec. 1980. Recovered dead under Tasman Bridge, River Derwent, Tas. on 30 June 1999, over 18 years 6 months after banding. 39 km N.

Little Tern Sterna albifrons

042-00608. Adult (2+) banded by VWSG on Albifrons Island, Ocean Grange Lakes National Park, Vic. (37°57'S, 147°47'E) on 13 Mar. 1999. Recaptured (released alive with band) at Jinnoshinden, Toyohashi City, Japan (34°44'N, 137°19'E) on 6 June 1999. 8 152 km N.

Rainbow Lorikeet Trichoglossus haematodus

025-01987. Nestling banded by C. Cannon at Currumbin Sanctuary, Qld. on 4 Dec. 1978. Recaptured at banding place (released alive with band) on 28 June 1999, over 20 years 6 months after banding.

(This is the oldest recorded for the species.)

Buff-rumped Thornbill Acanthiza reguloides

015-06318. Adult (1+) banded by D. R. Reid at Bradbury, SA on 9 Feb. 1986. Recaptured at banding place on 1 Jan. 1994, over 7 years 10 months after banding.

(This is the oldest recorded for the species.)

Yellow Thornbill Acanthiza nana

014-93312. Adult (1+) banded by G. R. Fry at Mount Annan Botanic Garden, Campbelltown, NSW on 23 Aug. 1987. Recaptured at banding place twice the last occasion by A. Heuchmer on 2 Aug. 1999, over 11 years 11 months after banding. (Band No. 018-15274 was added to the left leg of this bird in addition to the original band on the right leg this band was excessively worn and very thin.)

(This is the oldest recorded for the species.)

Southern Whiteface Aphelocephala leucopsis

020-49004. Adult (2+) banded by R. M. Gibbs at Bower, SA on 5 Oct. 1963. Recaptured at banding place by E. F. Boehm on 5 May 1972, over 8 years 7 months after banding.

(This is the oldest recorded for the species.)

Noisy Miner Manorina melanocephala

061-80016. Adult (1+) banded by A. W. J. Fletcher at Clear Lagoon, Tas. on 15 Apr. 1989. Recovered dead (taken by cat) at Sandford near banding place on 10 June 1999, over 10 years 1 month after banding.

Long-billed Honeyeater Melilestes megarhynchus

040-71456. Adult (1+) banded by K. D. Bishop at Baiyer River, West Highlands Province, Papua New Guinea on 17 July 1977. Recaptured at banding place by R. D. Mackay on 23 Oct. 1984, over 7 years 3 months after banding.

(This is the oldest recorded for the species.)

Dwarf Honeyeater Oedistoma iliolophus

010-14265. Adult (2+) banded by R. Schodde at Karema, Brown River, Papua New Guinea on 26 July 1962. Recaptured at banding place by E. Cleland on 16 Nov. 1969, over 7 years 3 months after banding.

(This is the oldest recorded for the species.)

Brown Honeyeater Lichmera indistincta

016-39590. Adult (2) male banded by R. J. Brown at Middlesex Field Study Centre, Manjimup, WA on 16 Sep. 1995. Recaptured at Millbrook Nature Reserve WA by B. G. Collins on 22 Nov. 1996. 168 km ESE.

(This is the longest movement recorded for the species.)

Scarlet Honeyeater Myzomela sanguinolenta

016-92055. Immature (1) banded by S. J. M. Blaber south of Mount Cotton, Qld. on 3 Aug. 1982. Recaptured at banding place on 15 Aug. 1992, over 10 years after banding.

(This is the oldest recorded for the species.)

White-faced Robin Tregellasia leucops

016-38662. Adult (1+) banded by M. J. G. Hopkins 22 km east-northeast of Port Moresby, Papua New Guinea on 23 Apr. 1991. Recaptured at banding place by R. K. Hicks on 11 Oct. 1998, over 7 years 5 months after banding.

(This is the oldest recorded for the species.)

Golden Whistler Pachycephala pectoralis

033-26093. Adult (3+) banded by G. P. Clancy at Skinners Creek, Moonee, Coffs Harbour, NSW on 29 Nov. 1989. Recovered dead (collided with moving road vehicle) west of Moonee, NSW on 19 June 1999, over 9 years 6 months after banding. 5 km W.

Grey Shrike-thrush Colluricincla harmonica

051-29580. Adult (1+) female banded by R. E. Corbould at Mildura Forest Reserve, Vic. on 13 Mar. 1988. Recaptured (found inside man made structure) at Mildura, Vic. on 1 June 1999, over 11 years 2 months after banding. 4 km SSE.

White-winged Chough Corcorax melanorhamphos

090-68874. Juvenile banded by A. Cockburn at the National Botanic Gardens, Canberra, ACT on 24 Oct. 1986. Recovered (colour marking sighted in field, band No. inferred) at banding place on 26 May 1997, over 10 years 7 months after banding.

Clamorous Reed-Warbler Acrocephalus stentoreus

033-03027. Adult (1+), banded by G. B. Winning at Shortland Wetlands Centre, Newcastle, NSW on 1 Nov. 1986. Recaptured at banding place by R. W. Reed on 1 Feb. 1993, over 6 years 3 months after banding.
