# RECOVERY ROUND-UP

This section is prepared with the co-operation of the Secretary, Australian Bird and Bat Banding Schemes, Australian Nature Conservation Agency. The recoveries are only a selection of the thousands received each year; they are not a complete list and should not be analysed in full or part without prior consent of the banders concerned. Longevity and distance records refer to the ABBBS unless otherwise stated. The distance is the shortest distance in kilometres along the direct line joining the place of banding and recovery; the compass direction refers to the same direct line. (There is no implication regarding the distance flown or the route followed by the bird). Where available ABBBS age codes have been included in the banding data.

Recovery or longevity items may be submitted directly to me whereupon their merits for inclusion will be considered.

131–89071. Nestling banded by N. P. Brothers on Macquarie Island, Tas. (54°00'S, 158°00'E) on 10 Mar. 96. Recovered dead at Kommetjie Beach, near Cape Town, South Africa (34°08'S, 18°19'E) on 9 June 96. 9 476 km SW.

## Wandering Albatross Diomedea exulans

- (a) 140-26431. Adult (1+) banded by H. Battam off Malabar, NSW (33°58'S, 151°20'E) on 7 July 69. Recaptured (released alive with band) on Antipodes Island, New Zealand (49°40'S, 178°48'E) on 22 Mar. 95, over 25 years 8 months after banding. 2 841 km SE.
- (b) 140-37482. Adult (5+) banded by S. G. Lane off Bellambi, NSW (34°20'S, 151°00'E) on 28 Aug. 87. Recaptured (released alive with band) on Antipodes Island, New Zealand (49°40'S, 178°48'E) on 19 Feb. 95, ovcr 6 years 7 months after banding. 2 833 km SE.

# Yellow-nosed Albatross Diomedea chlororhynchos

CF35643\*. Adult (3+) banded on Amsterdam Island, Indian Ocean (37°30'S, 77°50'E) on 20 Dec. 95. Recaptured (released alive with band) at King George Sound, Albany, WA (35°04'S, 118°00'E) by G. Kennedy on 6 May 96. 3 582 km E.

## Red-tailed Tropicbird Phaethon rubricauda

200-12026. Nestling banded by ANPWS CSP on Coringa Islet, Coral Sea (16°58'S, 149°56'E) on 9 May 90. Recaptured (released alive with band) on North-East Cay, Herald Cays, Coral Sea (16°57'S, 149°11'E) on 4 May 96, over 5 years 11 months after banding. 80 km W.

# Australasian Gannet Morus serrator

(a) 130–16699. Nestling banded by I. O'Connor on Lawrence Rocks, Portland, Vic. on 26 Dec. 60. Recaptured at banding place by C. G. Cooper on 19 Dec. 89, over 28 years 11 months after banding. (The bird was rebanded with band no: 131–71506.)

The Secretary of the ABBBS, Mr Tom Scotney reported that; "This band was illegible when sent in (in 1989). David Drynan managed to clean it up and get a number. (It is amazing what a piece of steel wool can do!!!)". This was after a number of high tech tests had been carried out on similar bands, these tests had failed to reveal the band numbers.

## Red-footed Booby Sula sula

270-01347. Juvenile banded by B. R. King on Raine Island, Qld (11°36′S, 144°01′E) on 14 June 81. Recaptured (released alive with band) on South Island, Willis Group, Coral Sea (16°17′S, 150°00′E) by ANPWS CSP on 7 May 96, over 14 years 10 months after banding. 829 km SE. (This is the longest movement recorded for this species.)

## Australian Pelican Pelecanus conspicillatus

170–04330. Nestling banded by M. H. Waterman on North Pelican Island, Coorong, SA on 16 Dec. 84. Recovered dead at Pound Bend, Vic. on 6 Apr. 96, over 11 years 3 months after banding. 312 km ENE.

## Bar-tailed Godwit Limosa lapponica

(a) 071-86884. Adult (2+) banded by AWSG at the Saltworks, Port Hedland, WA (20°15'S, 118°55'E) on 13 Apr 90. Recaptured (released alive with band) at Chongming Island, Shanghai, China (31°38'N, 121°27'E) on 9 Apr. 96, over 5 years 11 months after banding. 5 774 km N.

## Eastern Rosella Platycercus eximius
