- (c) 190-04679, Nestling banded by H. Battam on Big Island, Five Islands, NSW on 17 Nov. 77, Found dead at Wineglass Bay, Freycinet Peninsula, Tas. on 18 Jan. 78, 900 km SSW. (This is the longest movement recorded for this species).
- (d) 190-09225. Nestling banded by B, Robertson on Chalky Island, Tas. on 30 Nov. 77. Found dead at Urquharts Bluff, Vic. on 3 Feb. 78, 370 km WNW.

## Southern Giant-petrel Macronectes giganteus

131-06211. Immature banded by S. G. Lane off Bell-ambi, NSW (34° 22' S., 150° 51' E.) on 31 July 77. Remains ("band on dried leg") found at Ninety Mile Beach, New Zealand (34° 48' S., 173° 00' E.) on 24 Apr. 78, 1800 km E.

## Wedge-tailed Shearwater Pullinus pacificus

- (a) 160-36887, Nestling banded by L. Marsh at Rocky Point, Norfolk Island on 2 May 61, Recaptured near banding place by O. Evans on 12 Nov. 77, over 16 years 6 months after banding. (This is the oldest recorded for this species).
- (b) 161-41334. Nestling banded by N. M. Swanson on Mutton Bird Island, Coffs Harbour, NSW (30° 18' S., 153°09' E.) on 30 Mar, 75. Recovered in rice field (alive and healthy) at Hernani, Eastern Samar, Philipines (11°20' N., 125° 37' E.) 4 900 km NW.

### Darter Anhinga melanogaster

131-25344. Nestling banded by N. J. Favaloro at Lake Bitterang, Kulkyne State Forest, Vic. on 9 May 76. Shot near Wellington, SA on 14 Apr. 78, 283 km WSW.

#### **Black-faced Cormorant** Phalacrocorax fuscescens

130-85528. Nestling banded by M. H. Waterman on Winceby Island, Sir Joseph Banks Group, SA on 25 Apr. 69. Found dead at Kellidie Bay, Port Douglas, SA on 2 Apr. 78, over 8 years 11 months after banding, 72 km W. (This is the oldest recorded for this species).

# Pied Cormorant Phalacrocorax varius

130-96712. Nestling banded by M. H. Waterman at Fishermans Bay, Port Broughton, SA on 25 Apr. 70. Sighted while nesting at banding place in Apr. 77, over 6 years 11 months after banding.

## Black Cormorant Phalacrocorax carbo

- (a) 131-10779, Nestling banded by M. H. Waterman at Prohibited Island, Narrung, SA on 11 Apr. 76, Recovered at Barren Box Swamp, near Griffith, NSW about 25 Mar. 78, 640 km ENE.
- (b) 131-25612. Nestling banded by N. J. Favaloro at Lake Cantala, near Hattah, Vic. on 29 May 76. Shot at Wineglass Bay, Freycinet Peninsula, Tas, about 8 Apr. 78, 840 km. SSE.
- (c) 131-31583. Nestling banded by N, J. Favaloro at Lake Menindee, NSW on 7 Aug. 76. Recovered ("in very poor condition; caught by hand") near Bombala, NSW in December 77, 776 km SE.

## Little Black Cormorant

#### Phalacrocorax sulcirostris

110-13445. Nestling banded by B. Miller at Lake Brewster, near Hillston, NSW on 21 Mar. 74. Recovered ("caught in fishing net") at Broadwater, Clarence River, NSW on 9 Mar. 78, 830 km NE. (This is the longest movement recorded for this species.)

## Cattle Egret Ardeola ibis

100-30642. Nestling banded by J. Willows near Grafton, NSW on 10 Jan. 78. Recovered ("remains on railway track") at Granton, Tas. on 27 Apr. 78. 1 550 km SSW. (This is the longest movement recorded for this species).

# **Black Swan** Cygnus atratus

- (a) 140-29693. Adult male banded by L. W. Braithwaite at Lake Brewster, near Hillston, NSW on 13 Nov. 64. Found dead near banding place on 23 Apr. 78, over 13 years 5 months after banding. (This is the oldest recorded for this species).
- (b) 140-31527. Juvenile female banded by L. W. Braithwaite at Lake George, NSW on 22 Jan. 65. Shot at Lake Mulwala, NSW on 18 Mar. 78, over 13 years 2 months after banding, 352 km WSW.
- (c) 140-33330. Adult male banded by J. L. McKean at Lake Brewster, near Hillston, NSW on 14 Nov. 64. Recovered ("appeared to have been dead for some weeks") near Kyneton, Vic. in Oct. 77, about 12 years 10 months after banding, 480 km SSW,

# Cape Barren Goose Cereopsis novaehollandiae

150-26212. Immature banded by M. H. Waterman at Sir Joseph Banks Group, near Port Lincoln, SA on 11 Sept. 74. Found dead near Narrung, SA on 15 Feb. 78. 290 km ESF. (This is the longest movement recorded for this species).

# Brown Goshawk Accipiter fasciatus

100-14826. Nestling banded by N. J. Favaloro at Nowingi, Vic. on 30 Oct. 77. Shot at Murrumbateman, NSW in Feb. 78, 630 km E.

# **Curlew Sandpiper** Calidris ferruginea

040-71148. Banded by F. W. C. van Gessel at Kooragang Island, Hunter River, NSW (32° 56′ S., 151°47′ E.) on 29 Jan. 77. Recovered ("caught in fields; seriously injured and died later") at Huangp'u Commune, Chungshan County, China (22°31' N., 113°22' E.) on 14 May 78, 7 300 km NW. (This is the longest movement recorded for this species).

#### Southern Black-backed Gull Larus dominicanus

11-21007\*. Runner banded by R. M. Warneke at Seal Rocks, Vic. on 28 Feb. 74. Found dead (Full adult plumage) on beach near Grassy, King Island, Tas. by T. Liddy on 10 Dec. 77. 190 km SSW.

# **Bridled Tern** Sterna anaethetus

060-00842. Adult banded by F. Lindgren on Lancelin Island, WA on 28 Dec. 64. Recovered on egg at banding place on 14 Dec. 77, over 12 years 11 months after banding. (This is the oldest recorded for this species.)

# Crested Tern Sterna bergii

(a) 070-05835. Runner banded by J. B. Hood on Penguin Island, Beachport, SA on 13 Jan. 58. Recovered ("unable to fly") at Mordialloc, Vic. on 18 Apr. 78, over 20 years 3 months after banding, 460 km E. (This is the oldest recorded for this species.)

- (b) 070-48378. Banded by J. B. Hood on Penguin Island, Beachport, SA on 4 Jan. 64. Found ("dead on beach") at Forster, NSW on 20 Mar. 78, over 14 years 2 months after banding, 1 290 km ENE.
- (c) 071-09721. Nestling banded by M. H. Waterman on Penguin Island, Beachport, SA on 27 Dec. 71. Found dying near Trial Bay, NSW on 25 Feb. 78, 1 420 km ENE.
- (d) 071-17787. Breeding adult banded by M. H. Waterman on West Island, near Victor Harbor, SA on 10 Dec. 72. Found dead on beach near Somers, Westernport, Vic. on 26 Mar. 78, 644 km SE.

### Galah Cacatua roseicapilla

200-04024, Adult banded by E. B. Thomas 24 km north of Barham, NSW on 2 May 75. Found dead near Deniliquin, NSW on 18 May 78, 79 km E.

## Golden Whistler Pachycephala pectoralis

031-02986, Immature banded by S. G. Lane at Scheyville, near Windsor. NSW on 21 Aug. 71. Retrapped (adult female) at banding place on 6 May 78, over 6 years 8 months after banding.

# Superb Blue Wren Malurus cyaneus

011-99439. Immature male banded by S. G. Lane at North Ryde, NSW on 3 Aug. 69. Retrapped at banding place three times, the last occasion by L. W. Filewood on 10 June 78, over 8 years 10 months after banding.

#### **Speckled Warbler** Sericornis sagittatus

012-69376. Adult male banded by A. Cam at Scheyville, near Windsor, NSW on 21 July 73. Retrapped six times at banding place, the last occasion by G. Logan on 19 Mar. 77, over 3 years 8 months after banding.

#### Eastern Spinebill Acanthorhynchus tenuirostris

313-82572. Juvenile banded by N. Forde at Kuintpo Forest Area, SA on 27 Jan. 78. Found dead at St. Agnes, SA on 13 Mar. 78. 45 km N.

#### **Silvereye** Zosterops lateralis

- (a) 013-12400. Banded by R. J. Brown near Manjimup. WA on 23 Apr. 77, Shot at Karridale, WA on 8 Apr. 78. 99 km W.
- (b) 013-78919. Banded by P. de Rebeira at Wembley, WA on 12 June 77. Recovered at Allanson, WA (Finder's letter received 7 Apr. 78 — no other details). 151 km S.
- (c) 013-79133. Banded by P. de Rebeira at Yanchep, WA on 7 Mar. 77. Found dead at North Dandalup, WA on 12 Mar. 78, 112 km SSE.
