

Crested Tern *Sterna bergii*

- (a) 070-57476. Runner banded by M. H. Waterman on Penguin Island, Beachport, SA on 11 Jan. 64. Found dead at Lennox Head, NSW on 13 June 79, over 15 years 5 months after banding. 1 600 km NE.
- (b) 070-77504. Runner banded by M. H. Waterman on Penguin Island, Beachport, SA on 26 Dec. 69. Recaptured (band returned) at Cape Nelson, Vic. on 8 June 79, over 9 years 5 months after banding. 169 km SE.
- (c) 071-38731. Nestling banded by M. H. Waterman on Stonywell Island, The Coorong, SA on 16 Dec. 78. Recaptured near Brunswick Heads, NSW on 22 June 79. 1 590 km NE.

Golden Whistler *Pachycephala pectoralis*

- 030-75542. Immature banded by S. G. Lane near Appin, NSW on 30 Mar. 74. Recaptured at banding place six times, the last occasion as adult female on 18 Aug. 79, over 5 years 5 months after banding.

Grey Shrike-thrush *Colluricincla harmonica*

- 050-25279. Adult male banded by S. J. Wilson at New Chums Road, Brindabella Range, ACT on 24 Oct. 70. Recaptured at banding place three times, the last occasion by the Brindabella Banding Group (BBG) on 12 July 79, over 8 years 9 months after banding.

Superb Fairy-wren *Malurus cyaneus*

- 012-81030. Adult male banded by K. F. Silva at Main Ridge, Vic. on 24 May 78. Found dead. at Rosebud, Vic. on 20 May 79. 9 km WNW.

White-browed Scrubwren *Sericornis frontalis*

- 021-14449. Juvenile banded by S. J. Wilson at New Chums Road, Brindabella Range, ACT on 25 Jan. 69. Recaptured (adult male) at banding place four times, the last occasion by the BBG on 3 June 79, over 10 years 4 months after banding.

Striated Thornbill *Acanthiza lineata*

- (a) 012-31763. Banded by S. J. Wilson at New Chums Road, Brindabella Range, ACT on 5 Oct 69. Recaptured twice at banding place, the last occasion by the BBG on 25 Apr. 79, over 9 years 6 months after banding.
- (b) 012-38028. Banded by S. J. Wilson at New Chums Road, Brindabella Range, ACT on 4 Apr. 70. Recaptured twice at banding place, the last occasion by the BBG on 16 May 79, over 9 years 1 month after banding.
- (c) 012-60574. Banded by S. G. Lane near Appin, NSW on 8 June 74. Recaptured at banding place on 18 Aug. 79, over 5 years 2 months after banding.

Yellow-faced Honeyeater*Lichenostomus chrysops*

- 021-38533. Banded by I. Grant at Bushrangers Creek, Brindabella Range, ACT on 2 Oct. 65. Recaptured at banding place on 5 Mar. 78, over 12 years 5 months after banding.

White-plumed Honeyeater*Lichenostomus penicillatus*

- 021-34978. Juvenile banded by J. C. Ipsen at Lyal Glen, Vic. on 22 Mar. 69. Recaptured 6 times at banding place the last occasion on 30 June, 79, over 10 years 3 months after banding.

White-naped Honeyeater *Melithreptus lunatus*

- 021-49367. Banded by G. P. Clancy at North Ryde, NSW on 4 June 72. Recaptured near banding place by L. W. Filewood on 10 June 78, over 6 years after banding. 1.6 km SE.

Silvereye *Zosterops lateralis*

- (a) 013-11958. Banded by R. J. Brown at Middlesex near Manjimup, WA on 24 Mar. 77. Shot near Darkan, WA on 21 Mar. 79. 114 km NNE.
- (b) 013-88363. Banded by R. J. Brown at Middlesex, near Manjimup, WA on 4 Apr. 78. Recaptured (band returned) at Bridgetown, WA during May 79. 31 km N.
- (c) 013-93188. Banded by I. Rooke at Cowaramup, WA on 13 Jan. 79. Found shot at Leeuwin Vineyard, WA on 30 Mar. 79. 21 km SSE.

Pied Currawong *Strepera graculina*

- (a) 090-07293. Adult banded by D. G. Nicholls at Timbertop Vic. on 3 July 71. Found dead at Macs Cove, Howqua, Vic. on 30 May 79, over 7 years 10 months after banding. 11 km S.
- (b) 091-01289. Immature banded by B. Baker at Hughes, ACT on 2 June 73. Found dead near banding place on 1 July 79, over 6 years 1 month after banding.

Colour-marked Raptors

A research project involving the individual marking of Brown Goshawks *Accipiter fasciatus*, Marsh Harriers *Circus aeruginosus* and Brown Falcons *Falco berigora* with coloured wing tags is currently in progress on the Melbourne Metropolitan Board of Works farm at Werribee. I would appreciate information on any sightings but particularly those outside the M.M.B.W. farm. Birds may have only one or both wings tagged and some colours are more obvious than others. Some tags have a black lateral stripe through them.

Information required is: date, location, colour of wing tag or tags, the presence or absence of a black lateral stripe on the tags and the wing the tag is on.
