

« RECOVERY ROUND-UP »

The recoveries in this section are only a selection of the thousands received each year by the Australian Bird-banding Scheme; they are not a complete list and should not be analysed in full or in part without the prior consent of the banders concerned. Longevity and distance records refer to the ABBS unless otherwise stated. The distance is the shortest distance in kilometres along the direct line joining the place of banding and recovery; the compass direction refers to the same direct line. (There is no implication regarding the distance flown or the route followed by the bird).

Recovery or longevity items may be submitted directly to me where-upon their merits for inclusion will be considered.

Little Penguin *Eudyptula minor*

Light-mantled Sooty Albatross

Phoebastria palpebrata

121-11028. Nestling banded by ANARE on Macquarie Island. (54°45'S., 158°35'E.) on 11 Mar. 79. Recaptured near North Cape, Rangaunu Bay, New Zealand, (34°50'S., 173°11'E.) on 25 July 79. 2 500 km NNE. (This is the longest movement recorded for the species).

Southern Giant-Petrel *Macronectes giganteus*

130-50062. Banded by H. Battam off Malabar, NSW (33°50'S., 151°20'E.) on 15 Aug. 70. Recaptured on Litchfield Island, Antarctica (64°46'S., 64°03'W.) on 19 Jan. 79, over 8 years 5 months after banding. 8 700 km SSE.

Northern Giant-Petrel *Macronectes halli*

131-26443. Nestling banded by ANARE on Macquarie Island, (54°45'S., 158°35'E.) on 1 Jan. 76. Found dying at Wellington Harbour, New Zealand (41°16'S., 174°52'E.) on 11 Dec. 79. 1 900 km NE.

Wedge-tailed Shearwater *Puffinus pacificus*

- (a) 160-03240. Adult banded by N. M. Swanson on Mutton Bird Island, NSW on 1 Dec. 69. Recaptured three times at banding place, the last occasion by S. G. Lane on 28 Nov. 79, over 9 years 11 months after banding.
- (b) 160-17630. Adult banded by S. G. Lane on Mutton Bird Island, Coffs Harbour, NSW on 13 Dec. 66. Found dead on Windang Beach, NSW on 5 Jan. 80, over 13 years after banding. 540 km SSW.
- (c) 160-37382. Adult banded by H. Battam on Mutton Bird Island, NSW on 30 Nov. 69. Recaptured at banding place by S. G. Lane on 26 Nov. 79, over 9 years 11 months after banding.
- (d) 160-43565. Adult banded by H. Battam on Mutton Bird Island, NSW on 2 Dec. 69. Recaptured at banding place by S. G. Lane on 28 Nov. 79, over 9 years 11 months after banding.
- (e) 160-43626. Adult banded by H. Battam on Big Island, Five Islands, NSW on 14 Dec. 68. Recaptured at banding place by S. G. Lane on 22 Dec. 79, over 11 years after banding.

Short-tailed Shearwater *Puffinus tenuirostris*

- (a) 160-08305. Nestling banded by S. J. J. F. Davies on Tollgate Islands, NSW on 6 Apr. 59. Recaptured at banding place by H. Battam on 5 Dec. 79, over 20 years 8 months after banding. (This is the oldest recovery of this species in the ABBS; however, older birds have been reported—*Aust. Bird Bander* 8:61).

Australian Pelican *Pelicanus conspicillatus*

Australasian Gannet *Morus serrator*

Great Cormorant *Phalacrocorax carbo*

Pied Cormorant *Phalacrocorax varius*

Magpie Goose *Anseranas semipalmata*

130-10156. Adult banded by H. J. Frith at Litchfield Creek, NT on 11 Dec. 57. Found shot at banding place on 18 Sept. 79, over 21 years 9 months after banding. (This is the oldest recovery recorded for the species).

Black Swan *Cygnus atratus*

140-34290. Immature banded by R. J. Thomas at Lake Wendouree, Ballarat, Vic. on 14 Jan. 74. Recaptured at Lake Guthridge, Sale, Vic. on 22 Sept. 79, over 5 years 8 months after banding. 300 km ESE.

Cape Barren Goose *Cereopsis novaehollandiae*

150-28966. Juvenile banded by R. B. Jenkins at Stickney, SA on 18 Sept. 79. Found dead near Sellicks Hill, SA on 10 Jan. 80. 213 km ESE.

Sharp-tailed Sandpiper *Calidris acuminata*

Crested Tern *Sterna bergii*

Torresian Imperial-Pigeon *Ducula spilorrhoa*

Red Wattlebird *Anthochaera carunculata*

White-cheeked Honeyeater *Phylidonyris nigra*

031-96818. Immature banded by T. H. Alley near Lennox Head, NSW on 5 July 79. Recaptured by J. Willows at Byron Bay, NSW on 17 Oct. 79. 17 km N.

Eastern Spinebill *Acanthorhynchus tenuirostris*

House Sparrow *Passer domesticus*

Common Starling *Sturnus vulgaris*

060-88195. Adult banded by C. R. Jenkin at Blackwood, SA on 26 Mar. 74. Found dead (decomposed) at Belair, SA on 4 Oct. 79, over 5 years 5 months after banding. 3 km NNE.

White-winged Chough

Corcorax melanorhamphos

090-03957. Banded by G. Massey at Cooma, NSW on 25 Aug. 74. Found dead near Berridale, NSW on 27 June 79. 10 km NW.

Pied Currawong *Strepera graculina*

090-27223. Banded by A. Marsland at Bogong, Vic. on 2 Oct. 78. Found shot at Rutherglen, Vic on 21 Oct. 79. 108 km NW.

Colour-banding of Pacific Gulls

A number of runner and free-flying Pacific Gulls *Larus pacificus*, have been banded near Flinders Island, Tasmania, and on the islands off Wilsons Promontory, Victoria. All birds have a CSIRO numbered metal band. Some birds have one colour band on the leg not holding the metal band while others have two colour bands on this leg and one colour band over the metal band. All bands were placed on the tarsus.

Colour of the leg band (s)

the leg the bands are on

Care should be exercised to confirm the identification of the gull as Kelp Gulls are being colour-banded by other workers.
