Colour-banding of Pacific Gulls

A number of runner and free-flying Pacific Gulls Larus pacificus, have been banded near Flinders Island, Tasmania, and on the islands off Wilsons Promontory, Victoria, All birds have a CSIRO numbered metal band. Some birds have one colour band on the leg not holding the metal band while others have two colour bands on this leg and one colour band over the metal band. All bands were placed on the tarsus.
