habits (Pedler 1976, pers. obs.) and thus seems more suited to hunting introduced rodents such as House Mice which are active both at night and during the day. House Mice predominate in the diet of the Black-shouldered Kite (Meredith 1977, Baker-Gabb unpublished data).

Localised plagues of House Mice in the Strzelecki Track region have been a major factor in the recent breeding successes in colonies of Letter-winged Kites (J. & L. Cupper pers. comm). If House Mice are becoming predominant in the annual diet of the Letter-winged Kite in many inland regions it will be interesting to see what influence this has on phenomena such as its frequency of breeding success, its nocturnal hunting behaviour and its potential for increased competition with the Blackshouldered Kite.


