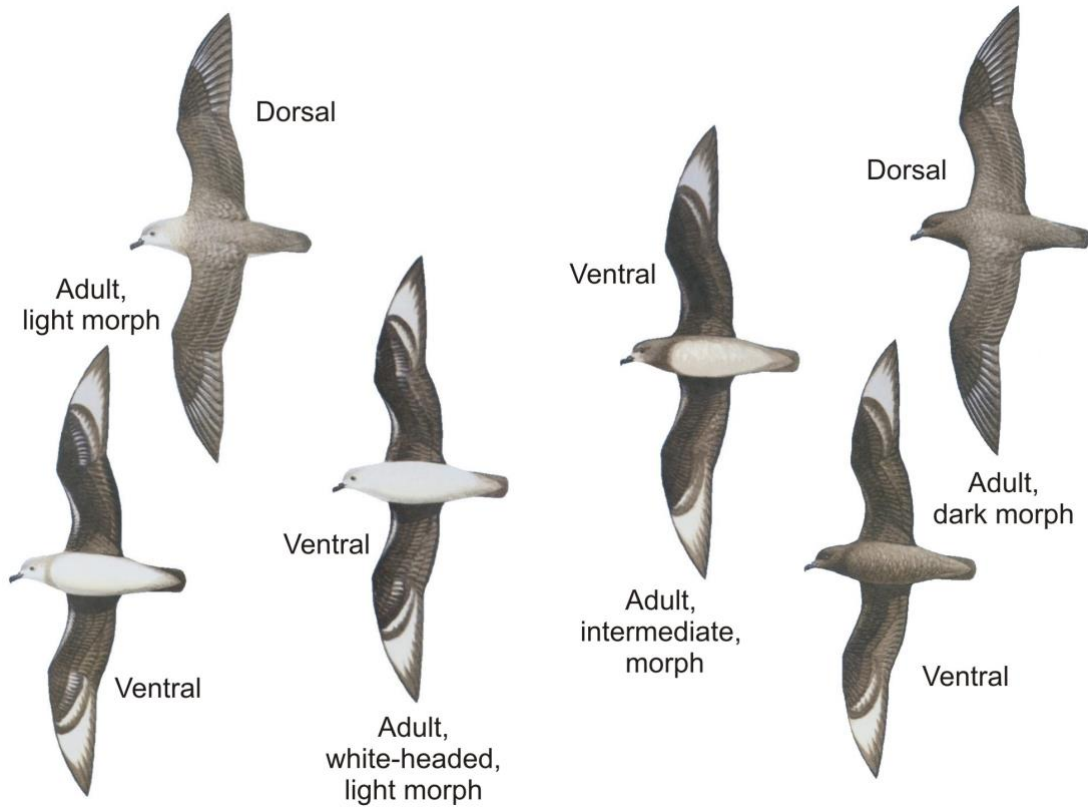


**Kermadec Petrel** *Pterodroma neglecta*

**Species Code.: 100 Band: E(SS)**



**Morphometrics:**

Two subspecies which both breed in the subtropical South Pacific Ocean – measurements below are for the nominate *P.n. neglecta* which breeds on south-western Pacific islands, including Lord Howe & Kermadec Islands; ssp. *P.n. juana* breeds in the south-eastern Pacific:

Tail:	92.4 – 113.3 mm	97 – 112 mm
Bill (tip to skull):	28.5 – 32.6 mm	28.7 – 38.5 mm
Tarsus:	35.2 – 41.8 mm	33.2 – 43.1 mm
Middle Toe:	46.4 – 57 mm	48.7 – 56 mm
Weight:	370 – 590 g	

**Ageing:**

Extremely variable plumage morphs (see illustrations above);  
 Juveniles and adults have similar plumage and bare parts;  
 No information on age at first breeding;

**Sexing:**

No sexual dimorphism;  
 No information on incubation roles.
