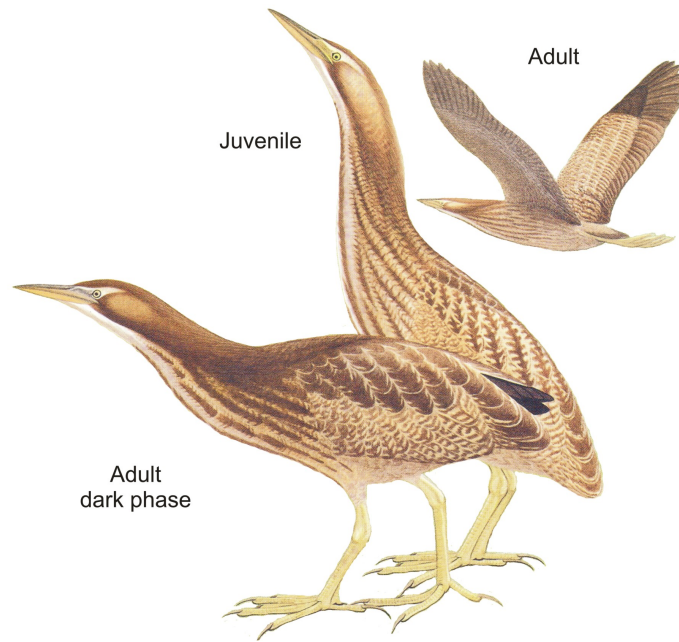


Australasian Bittern *Botaurus poiciloptilus*

Ageing:

	Adult (2+)	Juvenile
Bill:	straw yellow to buff with dark grey, dark blue-grey or grey-black culmen;	greenish yellow to olive-grey with dark grey-brownish culmen;
Iris:	orange-buff to brown or yellow;	yellow;
Facial skin:	encroaches onto base of bill, in some light grey or light bluish grey to grey, but in others green and darker at tomia with dark olive-brown stripe from eye to nostrils;	light green, greenish yellow behind and below eye with narrow black-green stripe from eye to nostrils;

Little data available on plumage, except that juveniles tend to be lighter than adults, but some adults are very pale not unlike juveniles;

No information on moult sequences, so age all adults as (1+).

Sexing:

Some adult males are larger than adult females, but there are overlaps in all measurements – see measurements above;

There is no information on incubation.
