RECOVERY ROUND-UP

This section is prepared with the co-operation of the Secretary, Australian Bird and Bat Banding Schemes, Australian Nature Conservation Agency. The recoveries are only a selection of the thousands received each year; they are not a complete list and should not be analysed in full or part without prior consent of the banders concerned. Longevity and distance records refer to the ABBBS unless otherwise stated. The distance is the shortest distance in kilometres along the direct line joining the place of banding and recovery; the compass direction refers to the same direct line. (There is no implication regarding the distance flown or the route followed by the bird). Where available ABBBS age codes have been included in the banding data.

Recovery or longevity items may be submitted directly to me whereupon their merits for inclusion will be considered.

Black Swan Cygnus atratus

280-15099. Nestling female banded by G. P. Clancy at Serpentine Channel, Chatsworth Island, NSW on 1 Sep. 2010. Band number read in field (bird not trapped) at Wellington Point, Qld. on 26 Jan 2023, over 12 years, 4 months after banding. 211 km N.

Grey Goshawk Accipiter novaehollandiae

- 101-26514. Juvenile (1) male banded by P. J. Tonelli at Springfield Park, Northdown, Tas. on 25 Feb. 2009. Recovered, released alive with band at Acacia Hills, Tas. on 16 Mar. 2023, over 14 years after banding. 19 km WSW.

Bush Stone-curlew Burhinus grallarius

111-26392 plus engraved leg flag: Yellow E4. Nestling banded by G. P. Clancy at Boyd's Bay, Tweed River, NSW on 13 Dec. 2018. Readable flag sighted twice, the last occasion by C. Andrews at Tweed Head Holiday Park, NSW on 4 Oct. 2023, over 4 years, 9 months after banding.

- (c) 101-21421 plus engraved leg flag: Yellow A3. Nestling banded by G. P. Clancy at Jerusalem Creek, Bundjalung, National Park, NSW on 20 Oct. 2006. Leg flag sighted, band number inferred on sixty occasions all within 147 km of the banding site, the last occasion by Mr Johnson at Picnic Area Beach, Broadwater National Park, NSW on 21 Jul. 2023, over 16 years, 9 months after banding 22 km N.

Recaptured, released alive with ABBBS band by VWSG at Stockyard Point, Vic. (38° 20'S, 145° 31'E) on 23 Feb. 2023, over 4 years 9 months after banding. 8,042 km SSE

Curlew Sandpiper Calidris ferruginea

Pacific Gull Larus pacificus

Sulphur-crested Cockatoo Cacatua galerita

220-05007 plus wing tag: Yellow 12. Adult (2+) banded by J. M. Martin at the Royal Botanic Garden and Domain, Sydney, NSW on 11 Nov. 2011. Colour marking sighted in field (band number inferred) at Naremburn, NSW on 12 Oct. 2022, over 10 years, 10 months after banding. 6 km NNW.

Pale-headed Rosella Platycercus adscitus

240-30813. Adult (2+) female banded by J. T. Coleman at Shailer Park, Qld. on 4 Nov. 2012. Recaptured, released alive with band at banding place twice, the last occasion on 2 Oct. 2022, over 9 years 10 months after banding.

Satin Bowerbird Ptilonorhynchus violaceus
